What is the Tara Sawyer Foundation?

A faith-based organization committed to supporting and enabling young athletes, children and families in need through scholarships, camps and outreach programs. The Foundation was created for Tara Sawyer, a vibrant Christian spirit who at the age of 10 passed from this world due to a water-borne parasite and resulting disease that she contracted while swimming with friends and family in a Texas Lake. To keep Tara's memory alive her family created the baseball tournament: The Tara Sawyer Classic. The Tournament, in honor of Tara who was the only girl on a select baseball team that made it to the USSSA World Series, raises funds for local families in need as well as scholarships for the Royal Family Kids Camp, a camp for abused and neglected children, and Life Outreach International's Water for Life program, providing safe wells in impoverished nations around the world.
